From the 1st December, the First Sunday of Advent, we shall be using the Revised Lectionary with a new translation of the readings for Mass. Some parishioners have enquired about purchasing a copy of the revised Sunday Missal. These are available from the Catholic Truth Society priced at £19.99. The Weekday Missal will not be published until early next year.
